



## Instrument Care Contract

### I will:

- Only clean my Ukulele with a soft cloth
- Never put my Ukulele in water, soap, or any other liquid, or get it wet
- Keep my Ukulele in its case when I am not playing it
- Never leave my Ukulele on a sofa, chair, table, or any other surface unless in its case
- Always make sure the case is closed securely
- Never write, put tape, or anything sticky on my Ukulele
- Never leave my Ukulele in direct sunlight, outside, or in any hot areas
- ***Never leave my Ukulele in a car or in its trunk***
- Wash my hands before playing my Ukulele
- Never eat or drink anything while playing my Ukulele
- Never let anyone touch my Ukulele other than myself and my teachers
- Report any damage to my Ukulele to my GALA teachers immediately
- Never attempt to repair my Ukulele on my own

Ukuleles will be owned by the student after 4 months of continuous involvement with and attendance at Global Arts. Until that point, all Ukuleles will be on loan. If the student does not wish to own their Ukulele, it must be returned to Global Arts upon exiting the program, or at any time requested by Global Arts staff.
